

MobileComm Tech to launch products

After initial hiccups, MobileComm Technologies India Pvt. Ltd, the wholly owned Indian subsidiary of US based MobileComm Professionals, Inc. is ready to formally launch its operations in India. It will also launch products in the domestic market.

MobileComm Professionals has been clocking on-year 150% growth.

The Indian entity of MobileComm Professionals is focussing on developing value added services platform and products for the Indian telecom industry. mCarbon is a value added services (VAS) product that the US company propose to launch.

With cellular technology changing by the day, MobileComm Professionals is working on 3rd generation technologies like Universal Mobile Telecommunication System (UMTS). MobileComm Professionals, Gurmeet S Likhari, President and Promoter says cellphones having become like handheld devices, there is a need for bigger and better bandwidth.
